## Notes to the form of proxy

- As a member of the Company you are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote at a general meeting of the Company. You can only appoint a proxy using the procedures set out in these notes.
- 2. To appoint as your proxy a person other than the Chairman of the meeting, insert their full name in the box. If you sign and return this form of proxy with no name inserted in the box, the Chairman of the meeting will be deemed to be your proxy. A proxy does not need to be a member of the Company but as explained in the notice convening the Annual General Meeting, given the current coronavirus (Covid-19 situation, shareholders are urged to appoint the Chairman of the meeting as his or her proxy as any other person so appointed will not be permitted to attend the meeting. Shareholders are also encouraged to submit their proxy form electronically.
